With all the new Commissioners Court and a new County Judge, the Officer is attempting to have it on the Agenda for the first meeting in February. The homeowner will be summonsed to Commissioner's Court who will judge him guilty or not guilty.

Mary Jo Aymes, Ann Stewart, and Jim Johnson presented the donations to the Fire Department. It was stated that during the visit that no other subdivisions donate to the VFD. A new fire truck was purchased for \$98k.
