The next road project will be to take care of the roads in proposal #2, presented by Bill Hutcheson.

The members approved the request to get a bid on moving the flag pole to a better location and getting a new American flag as well as displaying the Texas flag. President Gill Groendyke will donate the Texas Flag. Paulette Brooks agreed to get the bid.

The members also agreed that very unattractive trees behind the Civic club need to be cut down. A bid for that will also be presented at the October meeting to be voted on. Jo Carol Wells agreed to get the bid.

President, Gil Groendyke asked for volunteers to get our methods and procedures very clear to present to the new officers at the October meeting.

## Road Presentation 7/8/17

The Ladies Aux would like to propose work to be done on Cree and a small section of Indian Shore.

My belief is we are stronger when we work together and I hope you all will see our intent here is to better our neighborhood and to use the money we have raised for the intended purpose.

Before I open this up for discussion I'd like to give you all our information.

How did we pick Cree and part of Indian Shore?

- 1. We looked at the need big pot holes etc
- 2. We looked for a smaller area that we could afford
- 3. We looked for homeowners help
- 4. We looked at well-traveled road
- 5. Also wanted to do a road we could advertise with signs afterwards so we would have more homeowner input for future roads we plan on getting done. We felt like this area is a cut through and a lot would see the work and signs we plan on put to advertise for more \$\$

## Where did we come up with the money?

- The fundraisers from the ladies aux along with a lot of club members help we have been collecting money for a while and saying we were doing roads and so far nothing - we felt like it is time
- 2. The Civic Club has collected \$700 designated for roads we would like you to vote on pooling that money with the ladies aux road fund
- 3. We have two homeowners living on these two streets that have committed to giving to this project


#### Where did we get the bid?

- Bob Willis County Commissioner put the designated road out for bid and the best bid was CCC Blacktopping out of Onalaska
- 2. \$13.15 per square yards pretty good bid some of them were in the \$20 range

### What type of road will this be:

- 1. The County will prepare the roads then The Blacktop company will do a 2" overlay of Hot mix Asphalt
- 2. The bid includes Material, Labor and Mobilization Blacktopping LLC furnishes 2 million in General Liability, Workers Comp and Commercial Auto Coverage
- 3. Blacktopping Company will warranty the quality of its materials and workmanship but will not warranty base failures because of instability or irregularities beneath the sub strata of their work. Warranty will be for a period of 1 year form the date of completion. Blacktopping Company will not be responsible for damages because of public driving on areas where prime has been applied
